Dock assignments at CLSA are managed by seniority. New members will be contacted by the club harbormaster and will be given their choice of vacant docks. Our dock spaces as provided by the state park system are numbered spaces along a seawall, with small triangular wooden platforms for ease of boarding. There is no traditional solid dock platform extending into the lake to tie boats onto. Consequently, most of our members use lifts that sit on the bottom of the lake and which are cranked up manually to raise the boat out of the water. Boats can be moored without a lift by installing a stern mooring buoy to tie off on. Lifts are member owned, and frequently used lifts are available for sale. New lifts can also be purchased from dealers, but must have rear legs sufficient to accommodate a 10 foot lake bottom.
