

Cowan Lake Sailing Association Membership and Fees Schedule

Full membership: If you plan on keeping a boat at Cowan Lake during the sailing season, you should become a Full Member. Full members and their immediate families, including children and grandchildren age 25 or under, have full grounds privileges (including camping, picnic, and facilities use), access to CLSA-owned power or sailing vessels, and priority access to CLSA social and training programs. Full members and their families also have unlimited accompanied-guest privileges and voting privileges (one vote per Full membership). Everyone in the member family is eligible to hold any CLSA office.

Full members are required to participate in 2 work parties and 2 race/safety duties per season. A Capital Improvement Fee is due when first becoming a Full member. A full member or member family must own a sailboat, and is obligated to rent at least one dock or one rack through CLSA.

Young Adult Membership: Junior memberships are available to those aged 28 or under. Junior members have all the same privileges and obligations as full members. Junior members must own a sailboat and are obligated to rent at least one dock or rack through CLSA. The Capital improvement fee is deferred until the time at which the Junior Member becomes a full member.

Associate Membership: If you do not plan on keeping a boat at Cowan Lake during the sailing season, then Associate membership is for you. Associate members and their immediate families have full grounds privileges (including camping, picnic, and facilities use) except for the sailboat dry storage area. They have priority access to CLSA social and training programs and unlimited accompanied-guest privileges. Family members are eligible to hold any CLSA office except for Commodore or Vice-Commodore. Associate members have no voting rights. Associate members may not keep a boat on CLSA property, and may only operate CLSA-owned power vessels when fulfilling their race/safety duties.

Associate members are required to participate in 1 work party and 1 race/safety duty per season. Associate members are not eligible for dock or rack rental through CLSA.

Youth Membership: This special membership category is for young sailors who are at least 9 years of age but not yet 18, and are participants in the CLSA Youth Training program. Youth members have facilities privileges when accompanied by an adult, have boat storage privileges, and have access to all CLSA social and training programs. They have no voting rights and may not operate club-owned power vessels.

Youth members are required to participate in 2 work parties per year. Youth members must either own or have access to an appropriate boat for the Youth Training program in which they enroll, and may rent a boat rack through CLSA. There is no capital improvement fee.

Sustaining Membership: Full members who do not plan to sail at Cowan Lake during the upcoming season have the option of becoming sustaining members. Sustaining members are invited to participate in all CLSA social programs, and may use club picnic facilities. Sustaining members do not serve work party or race/safety duty assignments and do not have voting privileges.
